

**August 1, 2011**

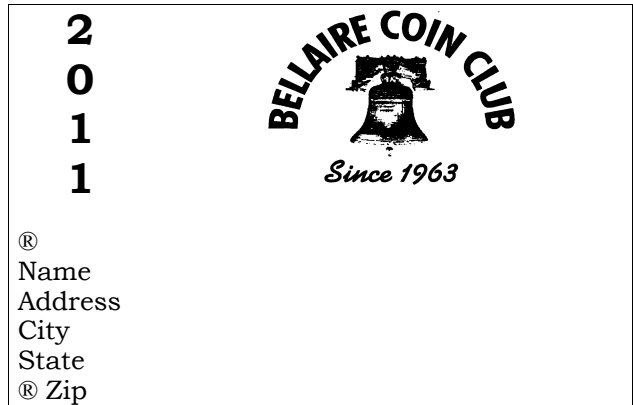

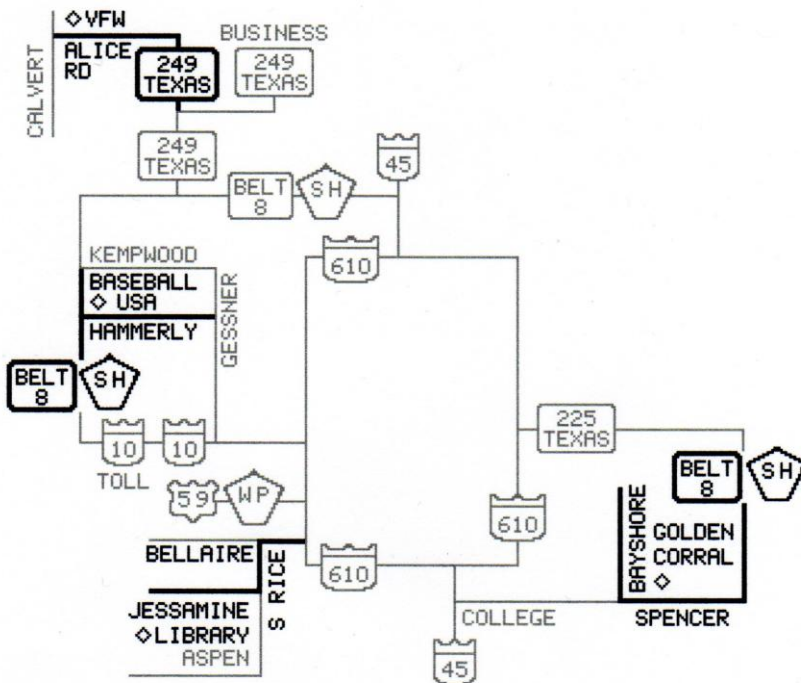
