APPLICATION FOR A TABLE

The table fees are as follows: 8' table \$295 each, 8' x 8' corners \$495 each, and 8' x 8' island corners \$550 each. The bourse area consists of table, name sign, night cover, chairs, two I.D. badges for each 8' table and four I.D. badges for each corner table (each additional badge is \$25), electrical outlets for lamp connections, and 24 hour security. Showcases and lamps are available on a reservation basis only. No free cases or lamps are furnished. Dealers will be charged \$10 for each lost key or for failure to turn in rental case keys. **Dealer set up is Thursday, May 13th, from 2:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. All dealers must be a current member of the TNA, at least 21 years of age, and have a valid Sales Tax number.** No sales tax is due on individual sales of coins or currency of \$1,000 or more. Any balance is due by March 15, 2010. Mail your \$20.00 in dues to Hal Cherry before the show. Application may be cancelled in writing and payment refunded prior to March 15, 2010. **CANCELLATIONS made after March 15, 2010 will forfeit all money whether table is resold or not. EARLY BIRD BADGES ARE AVAILABLE FOR \$35.00.**

More than 50% of the material on display on an applicant's table must consist of numismatic material. Replicas, copies, or restrikes must be plainly marked and advertised to the prospective buyer. No altered or counterfeit numismatic material may be sold. The TNA reserves the right to restrict the sale of material which it deems contrary to the benefit of the "2010 Texas State TNA Coin & Currency Show", or its attendees, and shall remove such items without recourse. A willful violation may result in individuals being barred from future TNA shows.

Bourse space SHALL NOT be resold, rented, or loaned to another dealer without the consent of the Show Producers. Dealers will be allowed one additional sign per table (one sign supplied by the TNA) to place on their table. Such sign CANNOT EXCEED 2' x 3', and CANNOT BE SUSPENDED ON POLES, POSTS, OR WALLS. No balloons or blinking lights are allowed---when in doubt ask the Show Producers.
